News from Forum Synergies members & partners

1st workshop "Sustainable development in Lake Areas", 15-18 June at Lake Võrtsjärv, EE

The first workshop of our thematic exchange project "Sustainable Development in Lake Areas" (short "lake project") took place from 15-18 june 2008 at Lake Võrtsjärv in Estonia. 16 participants had an intensive time of exchanges, field visits and reflections about the general topic of empowering local initiatives and civil society in the framework of the implementation of EU environmental policy. Additionally to participants from six EU-countries, we



even could welcome NGO-activists from China and Botswana. The workshop was organized in co-operation with the "Living Lakes Network" of Global Nature Fund (<u>www.gnf.org</u>) and financially supported by Fondation de France's program "l'Europe en plus large". Forum Synergies Gathering "Our Common Good – Enhancing sustainable life-styles for ecological and social recovery", 26-27 June in Mas de Noguera, ES

The meeting was dedicated to an evaluation of our FS programme and planning of future activities. It also offered space for a political discussion on the main challenges for the Valencian region with representatives of civil society organisations and politicians in the region.

We had discussions about our strategy to strengthen FS membership and our relations with the "bigger family" of



European networks like ERA, ERCA, CURE or PREPARE. The logistical and programmatic preparation of the upcoming "European Rural Sustainability Gathering" taking place in Göhrde, Wendland, Germany from 8-11 October was another priority of the meeting.

We also enjoyed a field trip in Mas de Noguera and Pina del Montalgrao, a place which is involved in the Farmers Ecology project. As a side event on the 1st day there was held a special Farmers Ecology meeting, in which Spanish, Romanian and French groups exchanged on possible common activities to realize in the frame of Farmer's Ecology project we are drawing up.







During the meeting we also started a new methodological approach in order "to spread our messages and ideas". Video clips were produced where each participant had the opportunity to proudly present his or her local experience or project and the special relation with Forum Synergies. This exercise will be continued during the Wendland meeting. The video clips will be available on our FS website.



PREPARE Gathering Slovenia and Croatia

This years PREPARE gathering took place from 30th of June to 4th of July in **Ptuj**, Slovenia, and **Stubicke Toplice**, Croatia, hosted by the Slovenian and the Croatian Rural Development Networks. The core theme of the meeting was "Economic recovery of rural areas and involvement of civil society in the enlargement process in South Eastern Europe and new neighbor countries".

About 80 participants from Albania, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Finland, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Macedonia, Poland, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Sweden, Ukraine, and the European Institutions took part in "travelling workshops" focusing on good practices in sustainable, bottom-up rural development in both countries. The gathering focussed on needs and potential of the South European Region (SEE), the role of rural civil society in building rural networks and strengthening cooperation between EU member countries, accession countries and neighbouring countries from the region.

 CURE seminar on urban-rural linkages fostering social cohesion in Europe, 2 July 2009 in Brussels

The third seminar on urban-rural linkages organised by DG Regio in collaboration with the **Universities of Gloucestershire** and of the **West of England** took place on the **2nd of July 2009** in Brussels.

The debate was oriented by 4 key note speeches:

- Presentation from Directorate-General for Employment, Social Affairs and EqualOpportunities (Antonia Carparelli, Head of Unit, Inclusion, Social Policy Aspects ofMigration, Streamlining of Social Policies)
- Keynote speach: "A learning agenda for promoting urban-rural linkages and socialcohesion" (Seija Virkkala, Professor of Regional Studies, Faculty of Public Administration, University of Vaasa)
- Rural-Urban linkages and social cohesion: a position paper (lan Smith and Paul Courtney)
- Illustrating the issues of social cohesion and rural-urban linkages (Mark Sucksmith)

Re-announcement Estonian Rural Parliament

As already announced next week the 8th Rural Parliament of Estonian Villages will open its doors. From 5-6 August about 40 international guests will have a study trip in different counties of Estonia.

On the 7th of August an international conference will deal with the topic "**Development of rural areas needs our activities**". Topics will be: the Cooperation between different rural development organisations in order to influence EU and national rural development policies (ERA, ERCA, PREPARE, Forum Synergies); the possibilities of village associations (village movements) in implementing rural development strategies; changes of the CAP.

On the 8th of August about 10 working groups will gather and travel to several villages and on the 9th the Rural Parliament will be closed after a fair with handicrafts and farm products open to the general public and the final presentation of the working groups.

Twinning Project Dolina Strugu (PL), Ukraine

Since 2002 Dolina Strugu Association together with the Ukrainian partner has carried out several cross-border projects. We also run a INTERREG III A project entitled "Met by the knowledge".



The purpose of the project was:

- 1. to broaden and develop sustainable cross-border cooperation between organizations from Ukraine and Poland
- 2. to establish direct contacts among NGO employees
- 3. to initiate actions that led to the acquisition and improvement of the knowledge and skills on how to write and manage UE projects
- 4. to train NGO staff in acquiring funds for their organizations statutory activities

Twenty-nine persons representing a group of informal and non-governmental organizations from Ukraine participated in the project. The project familiarized its participants with the legal

aspect of organization activity through trainings. They acquired basic information needed to manage the funds available to Poland and Ukraine.

Ongoing activities

Activities in Farmers Ecology

The workshop "Local regulation of the access to natural resources" organised by AGTER (www.agter.asso.fr) and co-animated by F.Barret, took place in Rhône-Alpes (Beaufortain) and PACA region (Alpes de Hautes Provence), from 28 June to July 2, 2009. A previous similar event was organised in 2008 in Mexico, with mostly the same participants and the same objective: to stimulate the debate on the governance of natural resources management, to exchange experiences and to highlight the most important elements of success or failure in order to elaborate policy proposals and/or recommendations.

Local experiences visits, meetings with the main stakeholders, conclusion meeting at the end of each day, viewing of Mexico video helped knowing and analysing the initiatives. And the personal experience of the 15 Mexican and French participants, involved in the management of natural resources with participation of local communities was a rich added-value to the exchanges. Each experience will be summarized as a success story in AGTER website and some of the knowledge will be integrated into the Farmer's Ecology project.
