The Latvian Rural Communities Parliament (LRCP) takes place every two years and its goal is to jointly find successful solutions, as well as new opportunities for rural development, promoting cooperation between different stakeholders, identification of challenges and priorities at local, regional, national and European level. The principle of the Community Parliament is based on an equal dialogue, bringing together representatives of local and regional authorities, business, policy makers, academics, rural development professionals and enthusiasts to foster systematic changes by gathering practices and views. Several hundred interested people who have one goal: to find solutions for the sustainability of Latvia's countryside and to promote the well-being of the rural population. The LRCP will take place for the 6th time this summer, not only in search of answers, but also in connecting community leaders and good practices, creating positive impact becomes even stronger and resonates more widely. Conclusions will be summarized in a Resolution, which will serve as a roadmap for decisions on rural areas for the next two years.
