PPP association "Sernikon" is operating in two coastal municipalities north from Riga – Carnikava and Saulkrasti municipality. The LAG is the smallest in Latvia (130 km2 and 16 242 inhabitants)

Local Action group operates as LAG and FLAG- working with The European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development and European Maritime and Fisheries Fund.











Description of the activities carried out

The main idea of the internship was to acquire organizational, communication skills with local entrepreneurs, the municipality and NGOs, to explore and learn how LAGs work and implement community-led local development. I wanted to know how local action groups, EU projects helping for rural areas to be more interesting for tourists, business, young peoples.

I was working in association "Sernikon". Chairmen of the Board of association "Sernikon" Āris Ādlers teaches me about work in NGOs. 

I visited project places in Carnikava and Saulkrasti which was created by SERNIKON association. It is interesting, modern places for tourists and business, but it is also fit with nature. I saw ow important it is for villages and peoples which coming here.







SERNIKON invited me to attend a seminar about NGOs. I found out how many organisations is working in Latvia, how they are working and why peoples creating organisations. Āris Ādlers in seminar was talking about organization SERNIKON projects. I am more and more learned about projects and NGOs.



I visited Rundale gardens. It is one of the most beautiful decorative gardens in Europe. I am florist and landscaper, it was important to see this french style gardens for me. This garden is created in 1735/36 by Francesco Bartolomeo Rastrelli. Workers said, that it is only one this size rozes garden in Europe 12000 plants, 2,3 ha. Gardeners showed how they making new planting places for flowers. It was interesting experience for me.

Āris Ādlers showed me how interestning tourism objects is integrated to nature. We visited Ligatne old paper factory, and wooden road near sand caves, Bauskas Nature park, other small villages.











Latvian Rural Forum invited me to be participant in big meeting with peoples in Tūja village. I was watching and learning how LRF team was working, how they find out villages problems, how they started to make Village developement plan. I was learning how to comunicate with peoples, work in team, how to make interesting discussion. I was excited how professional they working. Discussions with peoples from Tūja was really useful.
